

Hopeful Four Community Giving Scholarship Application

Four Whitesboro Warrior students banded together during the Summer 2017 floods and again during the Halloween Floods which severely impacted our community. They carried out extreme acts of kindness including setting up a support fund to help victims of natural disasters. An outcome is the establishment of a \$250 scholarship to a college-bound graduating senior who has demonstrated community acts of kindness. The review of the applications is done by one school guidance counselor, the Warriors who have graduated & not graduating, and a teacher from the high school.

This scholarship is to be given to a graduating senior demonstrating character traits of kindness, generosity, and thoughtfulness. Applicant should be an outstanding student who applies themselves out in the community. The two hundred fifty dollar (\$250.00) award is to be applied toward first-year tuition costs of a graduating Whitesboro high school student. The award is based upon the following criteria:

The student must be a graduating senior and the student must demonstrate community giving traits outside of school required activities.
