

You can still enroll in school and may get free transportation under the McKinney-Vento Act.

WHO IS COVERED BY THE MCKINNEY-VENTO ACT?

CHILDREN AND YOUTH WHO DON'T HAVE A FIXED, ADEQUATE AND REGULAR NIGHTTIME RESIDENCE, SUCH AS THOSE LIVING:

- in an emergency or transitional shelter;
- with friends or relatives because of loss of housing or economic hardship (also known as doubled up);
- in a motel, hotel or campground;
- in a car, bus or train station or other public place;
- in an abandoned building or some other inadequate accommodations; or
- in temporary situations while awaiting foster care placement.

WHAT EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS DO STUDENTS HAVE WHEN LIVING IN TEMPORARY HOUSING?

THEY CAN:

- enroll in school and attend classes immediately;
- get free transportation;
- get free school meals without completing an application;
- participate in any school activity or program available to other students; and
- get special education services immediately if the student has a current IEP.

WHERE CAN STUDENTS GO TO SCHOOL WHEN LIVING IN TEMPORARY HOUSING?

THEY CAN CHOOSE FROM:

- the school they went to when permanently housed;
- the last school they went to; or
- the school located in the attendance area where they are temporarily living.

STUDENTS WHO TRANSFER SCHOOLS OFTEN DO WORSE IN SCHOOL THAN THOSE WHO DON'T TRANSFER.

THE MCKINNEY-VENTO ACT CAN HELP SOLVE THIS PROBLEM BY ALLOWING STUDENTS TO STAY IN THE SAME SCHOOL AND GET FREE TRANSPORTATION.
