Westerly Public Schools Nondiscrimination

No. 4130

It is the policy of the Westerly Public Schools not to discriminate in its educational programs, activities, or employment policies on the basis of age, color, gender, national origin, race, religion, sexual orientation, or disability (as required by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973).

This policy applies to students, parents, and employees of the Westerly Public Schools.

Identification, evaluation, and placement procedures are available, as well as grievance procedures that provide for the prompt and equitable resolution of complaints alleging violations of Section 504.
