How to Register

Students can enroll anytime during the calendar year. We are also open during the summer.

Students must be in 11th grade - age 21. They must be credit deficient or have other extra ordinary circumstances that prevent them from attending conventional school.

Lincoln High School houses the Open Doors Youth Reengagement Program (OD) under the supervision of Principal Marci Knauft, and lead teacher Riki Wauchek.

Students receive a flexible schedule and academic help needed to earn a GED certificate or a high school diploma.

Lincoln Open Doors is an official Pearson Vue GED testing center with official Pearson Vue certified proctors.

Open Doors registration is free. The cost of pre-GED tests, GED tests, and other certifications are covered for all registered students.
