

Public Notice of Intent to Apply for Federal Grant Funds

For the 2024-2025 school year, Bartlett ISD will apply for funding under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) of 2015

Based on previous year's programs and based on current year needs assessment data, Bartlett ISD plans to use these funds to support the intent and purpose of said grant.

Intent to apply for 2024-2024 funding under the ESSA Consolidated Grant will include:

| Title I, Part A | To provide all children significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps. | \$134,942 | Under the Schoolwide provisions of ESSA (Public Law 114-95 sec. 1114), these funds are used by the district to support instructional salaries and supplies to upgrade the entire educational program to raise the achievement of the lowest-achieving students. Bartlett ISD also uses these funds to comply with the Parent and Family Engagement provisions of ESSA. |
| Title II, Part A | The intent of the funding is to support educators in their work to improve the overall quality of instruction and ensure equity of educational opportunity for all students. | \$20,886 | These funds are used by the district to provide professional development and staff retention pay to meet the intent and purpose of the Title II, Part A Program. |
| Title III, Part A, ELA | To provide supplemental resources to help ensure that children who are English learners attain English proficiency at high levels in academic subjects and can meet state achievement performance standards. | \$8,447 | As a member of a shared service arrangement with ESC, Region 13, these funds are used by the district to provide the required professional development and to provide instructional supplies and materials for classroom activities to meet the intent and purpose of the Title III, Part A Program. |
| Title IV, Part A | The overarching goal of Title IV, Part A is to increase the capacity of state education agencies, local educational agencies (LEAs), campuses, and communities to meet the following three goals: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide all students access to a well-rounded education • Improve academic outcomes by maintaining safe and healthy students • Improve the use of technology to advance student academic achievement | \$10,104 | These funds are used by the district to provide comprehensive school-based mental health services. Bartlett ISD also uses these funds for accelerated learning programs in an effort to raise student academic achievement. |
