- 3. Determination of Conflict of Interest: No conflict of interest was determined to be present.
- 4. Approve Agenda: A motion to approve the May 23rd, 2023 agenda as presented was made by Gerard Cramer. Julie Cox seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- 5. Approval of Minutes: A motion was made to approve the April 25th, 2023 Board minutes as presented by David Smith. Brady Jones seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

1. School Activities Reports

Liz Burkwald presented for AFSA K-8

Academics:

- Star testing completed, data to be compiled for goals.
- OW Goal: Read Well testing goals of 84.2 % were met for 3rd graders reading at grade level. Community:
 - K-8 Awards Night will be June 1st (4-7pm)! All students will be recognized for their efforts this year. Kindergarten and 8th grade celebrations and an Ice Cream social hour will be held.

- Field Day June 9th will be fun and games in PALs groups to wrap up the year.

Mission:

Academics:

School Culture and Community:

- AFSA was awarded the outstanding Middle/High School program award by the MN Association of Agriculture Educators, and an application has been submitted for the national association.
- FFA Awards Banquet was a big success on 05/06/2023. Students won awards in academic content as well as 40 students lettered in athletics, academics or clubs. AFSA's 19 state agriscience fair and 5 national science fair finalists were recognized.
- AFSA annual Plant Sale/Fundraiser was a huge success with \$10,000 in sales(net \$7,000).
