

**NSU University School
Student Dress Code (JK-Grade 12)**

Shirts	- All students must wear a school uniform polo shirt with a branded NSU University School logo (purchased from one of our official school vendors) to school each day. Athletic and school club polos can only be worn on Fridays. - No excessively tight and short clothing may be worn - Midriffs must not be visible at any time - Shirts may not be altered by cutting or ripping
Pants/Shorts/Skorts	- Must be properly fitted uniform pants, shorts, skorts, or joggers - Length of shorts/skorts purchased from uniform vendors may not be altered or modified - Inseam for shorts must be 6.5 inches or longer. Skorts must be at least mid-thigh in length. - Students may wear black, gray, navy, or khaki shorts/skorts that adhere to inseam/length specifications. Uniform bottoms that are faded will be deemed non-compliant with the dress code. - No visible tights, stockings, leggings, yoga pants, etc. may be worn underneath shorts - Joggers (from any store) may be worn in lieu of shorts, skorts, or pants. Joggers must follow these specifications: - o joggers must be solid black, khaki, gray, or navy blue with no visible patterns, stripes, or images. - o the brand logo on the jogger (Nike, Lululemon, etc.) must be a “reasonable” size (approximately 2 inches by 2 inches or smaller) and placed in an appropriate location - o the joggers must be cinched at the bottom and fall below a student’s knee but above the shoe
Outerwear	- For upper body, only solid, one-color outerwear with the official NSU University School or NSU logo is permitted - School polo shirts must be worn under any outerwear - FHSAA outerwear with NSU University School listed are only permitted on Fridays - Sweatshirts may not extend past the waistline of shorts as shorts must be visible below outerwear - Sweatshirts may not be altered
Shoes	- Athletic shoes and closed shoes of any color but with substantial soles are permitted - Open-toed shoes, open-backed shoes, work or combat boots, Crocs, sandals, and Ugg slipper-style shoes (including TAZZ and TASMAN styles) are prohibited.
Hats	- No hats, hoods, or other head coverings are permitted inside school buildings unless for religious purposes or as approved by administration
Exposed Tattoos	- Prohibited
Body Piercing	- Visible body piercings, other than ears, are considered dress code violations - Students should not have more than two earrings, per ear, while at school
Hair Color and Style	- Only natural hair colors are allowed. (Extreme and/or distracting hair styles and colors will be treated as a dress code violation.)
Torn/Tattered Clothes	- Prohibited
Miscellaneous	- Inappropriate logos, images or slogans on backpacks, shoes, or other items of clothing or jewelry are not permitted.

Friday Spirit Days

On Fridays, students may wear any school sponsored shirt, T-shirt, or team polo with regular uniform pants, shorts, skorts, or joggers. FHSAA shirts are permitted on spirit days as long as they have NSU University School listed on them. Spirit shirts may not be cut or altered.

****Students dressed out of school uniform will be withheld from classes until an appropriate school uniform can be provided for them.**
