All Honors and AP Courses are not required, but rigor in the areas of previous academic success for the student is encouraged for IB DP Course preparation.

²Students who express an interest in the IB DP are eligible to take AP World History and/or AP Government/Economics in the Freshman and Sophomore years respectively.

³Students are encouraged to take a Modern Language class at their respective junior highs and can speak to their counselors about course sequence options when they enter high school. Students can also take *ab-initio* Mandarin their junior year with no prior knowledge.

⁴IB History of the Americas meets the ABOR American/Arizona History requirement.

⁵Students must complete Mathematics through Algebra II to be eligible for IB Math Applications junior year.
