Curriculum Council Electronic Voting Results

May 20, 2022

On May 12th, an electronic vote was sent out to council members to vote on three approved courses that were updated with a few changes. Below is a list of the proposed changes and the results of the electronic vote. 21 of 23 council members completed the electronic voting ballot.

1. AP Seminar

- a. Change grade level from 10-12 to 9-12. Reason: Some students are completing English 1 during 8th grade.
- b. Delete history and science electives change to only English elective. Reason: Students are learning how to research in AP Seminar; AP Research is when they do in depth research in a content area.
- c. Prerequisite change to English I or concurrent. Reason: Students completing English I in 8th grade and some schools are providing a block schedule with English I and AP Seminar.
 - i. 9 approved, 12 disapproved – DID NOT PASS

2. AP Research

- a. Add math to the department. Reason: Research can be done on a math topic.
- b. Prerequisite change to AP Seminar. Reason: AP Seminar and English I will provide a foundation for the research and writing.
 - i. 20 approved, 1 disapproved - PASSED

3. Fire Fighting Technology

- a. Add that Fire Fighting Technology could count as a science elective.
 - i. 21 approved, 0 disapproved - PASSED
