

PROGRESS MONITORING

When students receive parallel, small group, or individualized instruction their progress is checked at regular intervals to monitor the effectiveness of the instruction.



BASELINE OR UNIVERSAL SCREENING

All MSBSD students grades K-10 are assessed 2-3 times a year. Information from the screening and other data such as attendance, grades, and behavior are then used to identify individual student and program needs.

Multi-Tiered System of Supports

The MSBSD is committed to providing high quality instruction and support to promote the highest level of achievement for all students.

The Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) is a framework and a mindset that schools use to provide instruction and support that maximizes the level of academic and behavioral success of all students.

The key components of MTSS include:

- ✓ Universal screening of all students in the fall, winter, and spring of each school year in grades K-10
- ✓ Tiers of instruction that can be individualized in response to student need
- Ongoing data collection and progress monitoring to gauge progress and adjust instruction as needed
- ✓ Ongoing assessments to guide instruction
- √ School-wide expectations and supports
- ✓ Parent involvement
