The MTSS process is a systemic, continuous improvement framework in which data-based problem solving and decision making is practiced across all levels of the educational system for supporting students.

The MSBSD conducts universal screenings in the fall, winter, and spring of each school year. This information is used to identify students who require additional instructional support or who are ready to advance and deepen their knowledge through instructional enrichment.

During the school year, if your child needs additional help to meet learning goals, targeted instruction will be provided. This means that your student may be working with an educational professional other than his/her homeroom or content area teacher in an individual or small group setting.

The MSBSD is committed to ensuring each student makes significant academic progress in our schools. The MTSS process creates an educational system that focuses on success for all learners.
