Katy called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

The agenda for the September meeting and the minutes from the May meeting were approved.

Treasurer's report was read.

The Boyce Middle School PTO total assets currently is \$30,218.17 Current income for student activity fee is \$21,507. There are 385 memberships. The actual amount is higher than budgeted amount.

The Family Welcome Day that was held on Tues, August 16th cost \$324.29. There are welcome gifts left over from this year. We should have enough for next year.

PT council split \$495 to Council Directory and Welcome Committee, Arts Program and Spelling Bee.

There were some over payments and under payments for activity fees. Almost all of those people have been contacted. 8 over paid and 3 responded and said donate the extra amount, 1 needed refunded and the other 4 did not respond. Under payments – 1 paid, 2 did not respond.

Only 1 check was returned. 3 more checks on dispute – 1 over paid, 1 only paid for 1 child, and 1 has no name. Prema is working on these issues.

New officers for the 2016-2017 Boyce PTO have been reported to the state and the form is on file with the treasurer and Parent Teacher Council. The Boyce PTO Treasurer documents were provided to Denise Henning, volunteer and CPA, in August and we are waiting on the return of the audit to file our 2015/16 taxes.

Budget - See September Budget Report

A motion was made by Lucy Higginbotham and seconded by Lisa McMillan to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Amy has been on board for 9 years. June – passed the budget and curriculum review and recommendations. STEAM offerings – 300 kids participated, leadership academy – 300 hundred kids, 2 week gym class earns them credits to free up their schedule – 300 kids participated. Turf was replaced at high school stadium. Capital projects ad hoc committee – considering highest priority capital item projects. 3 big projects as priorities(discussion only) - Pool at high school, Boyce field has no rest room facilities, press box at the stadium. Committee is looking for input from organizations, teams & clubs for Public input. Refinancing some bonds to save money. Done periodically.

STEAM Design Teacher at Boyce. Presentation in the classroom on the program.

Kevin Clark & Matt Dudley - Deer Valley
