Five-in-a-Row

Materials: Gameboard, counters (about 20), two number cubes of or number cards 1-6.

Players: 2-5

Object: Cover five squares in a row horizontally, vertically or

diagonally

How to Play:

1. Each person has a separate game board.

2. Roll the number cubes (or turn up two Number Cards)

3. Find the sum of the rolls. Look at the board for a square that matches the sum. Place a counter on that square.

4. Continue in this way until you have covered five squares in a row. If no move can be made because that sum is already covered, roll again.

Variations:

- 1. Have them record the sums each time: 5 + 2 = 7
- 2. After recording all their sums, total how much the sums total. Whoever has the highest/lowest sum of sums wins.
 - 3. Roll three cubes and decide which two numbers to add together.
- 4. Create other game boards with higher numbers and use three cubes and total all three.
