

Ideas for Practicing Spelling Words

1. Rainbow words:
 - have your child write the word in pencil as she/he says each letter, then the word as in: p-o-l-e pole
 - next, use a color and retrace the word while saying each letter and the word
 - do this with two more colors, for a total of 4 times (the pencil and 3 colors)
2. Have your child use his/her finger to write the words in a tray of flour or sugar.
3. Use scrabble letters to spell the words.
4. Spell the words with magnetic letters on the fridge.
5. Type the words on the computer.
6. Write the words on graph paper with one letter per block.
7. Write the words in shaving cream or pudding.
8. Use a bar of soap or chalk to write the words.
9. Write the words in the air with a finger.

Always have your child say the phonograms as they write.

Anything where they are using “**see, say, touch**” is a good thing 😊
