# **Approval of Minutes**

➤ Rita Luce/Bob Barclift, Moved/Seconded (M.S.) to approve the minutes from the August 28, 2016 meeting as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Student Reports**

- Jayson Haury THS: Jayson shared that the ASB Officers plus some of the Leadership students went to the Mt. Baker Leadership Conference at Cispus over the summer. They had the opportunity to interact with students from several other schools around Washington. They brought back some great ideas. Fall sports are in full swing. Link crew orientation was on Tuesday. THS Open House will be on the 21<sup>st</sup> of September. Jayson thanked the construction crew, maintenance and custodial staff for getting the school ready for classes on Wednesday. Jayson discussed some of the goals of the ASB leaders this year.
- Ally Remy BHHS: Ally shared that Link day is very similar to Tumwater's. BHHS has more incoming freshman than in year's past. BHHS Spirit Fire is scheduled for September 17<sup>th</sup>. Clubs start on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. The Marching Band will be in its first competition on the 24<sup>th</sup> in Silverdale. There are several new teachers at BHHS this year. With the new security measures on the campus, some students are finding it inconvenient since exterior doors are locked. etc.

## Superintendent's Report

➤ Enrollment & Staffing Update: Beth Scouller displayed the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of school student enrollment counts. There is only one school that is lower than the same day last year. All other elementary schools are above projections. Kindergarten starts on Monday, so 4<sup>th</sup> day numbers will reflect those students. Secondary schools are also up except at Black Hills. Beth displayed a chart which showed the average annual FTE of students over the last six years. Certificated hiring update included 56 staff – 14 new to teaching. She reviewed the current vacant positions.

Superintendent Remarks: Sid Otton is entering his final season as THS Football Coach. He was chosen as Tumwater School District's Champions for Kids 2016. Peter G. Schmidt was featured in The Olympian on September 4<sup>th</sup>. The Preschool start date has been delayed due to contractor delays. Tentatively it is scheduled to start on September 19th. The Community Roundtable topics and meetings dates are being planned for the year. John presented draft topics/events. September's event will be held at the new Peter G. facility. John reviewed the WSSDA Boards of Distinction criteria. The 2016-17 school year is off to a positive start and he is receiving great feedback. Kudos to members of the district leadership team members for the heavy lifting over the summer to make a smooth start to the year. Today he met with John Doan and they discussed community partners, the second school resource officer position, city strategic planning, and emergency planning coordination.
