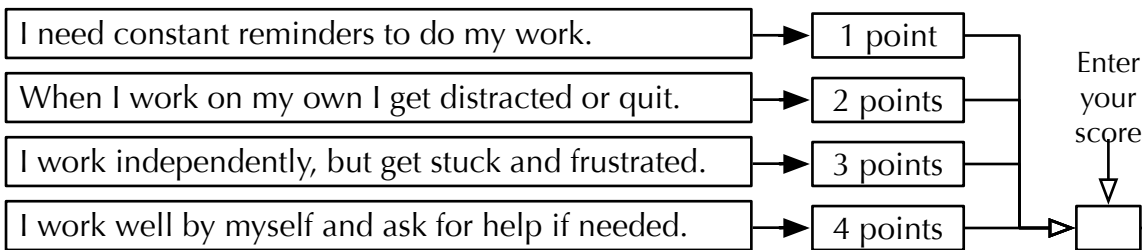

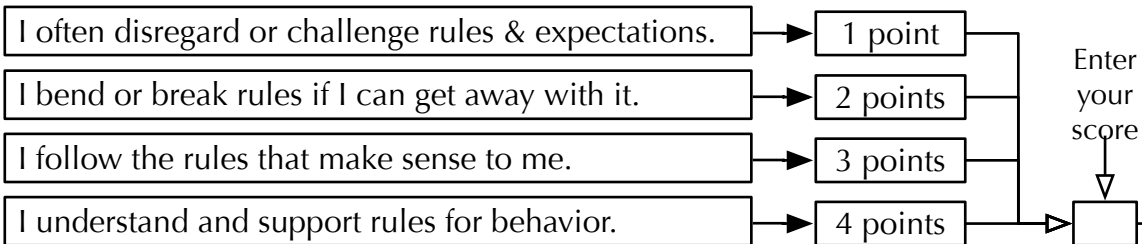

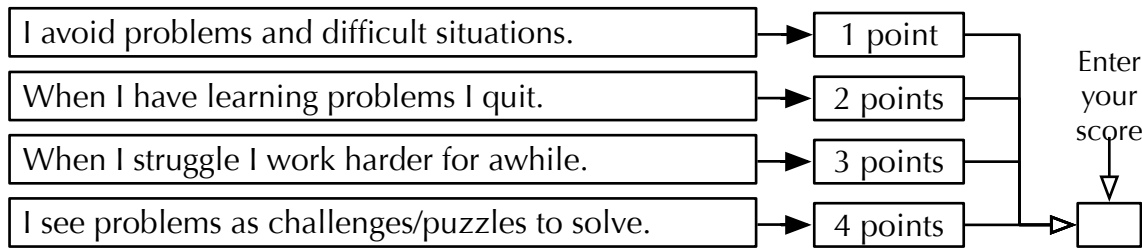
Working Independently



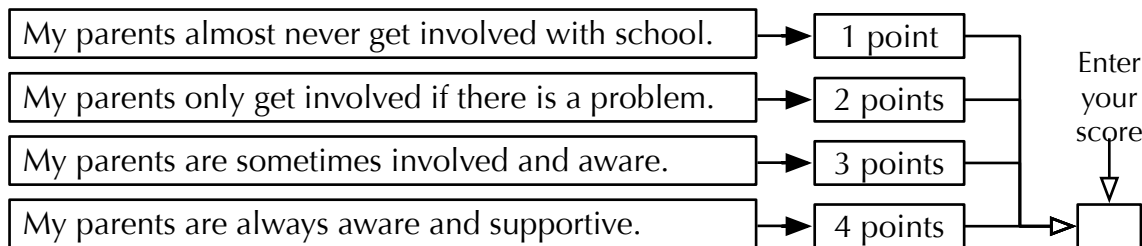

Language Readiness

Online Scholarship Readiness



Students scoring to the left end of this scale are likely to struggle with the independent nature of the hybrid model at College Pathways.

Students scoring to the right end of this scale are likely to thrive in the hybrid/college model at College Pathways.

Academic Readiness



Students scoring to the left end of this scale are likely to struggle with the academic pace and expectations at College Pathways.

Students scoring to the right end of this scale are likely to thrive in the academic environment at College Pathways.

For reflection: If both your scores fall to the same side of the midline, those scores reinforce each other. The reliability of both scores is stronger when they are relatively similar.

If your scores are split, then the overall picture is less clear. You may be developing your academic and scholarly habits at different rates.

Success in any school is a combination of the ability to learn and the support you have to be a diligent scholar. At College Pathways, the importance of diligence and scholarly habits is amplified because the hybrid model has less structured time and relies more on students and parents to stay engaged and active.
