Steps Completed to Date-Legally Binding Commitments to YOU

Hired an Architect

- Entire focus this year is on Higley High
- Contract included full design and permit drawings for Phase I- Classroom Building
- Also included design for Phase II- Competition Gym Remodel and Campus Re-imagining

In the process of hiring a Construction Manager at Risk

- Contract includes construction of Phase I- Classroom Building AND Phase II- Competition Gym Remodel if bond funding is approved
- Contract targets summer 2023 for both the classroom building and the gym if bond funding is approved







Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

Phase I- Classrooms required for enrollment

- Two story classroom building
- 12 classrooms and 2 lecture halls
- Take advantage of views of the football field and courtyard









Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

Phase II- Competition Gym-Pending Bond

- Studied a new gym vs renovation
- New gym: space on site would not fit a significantly larger gym than the current one









Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

Phase II- Competition Gym-Pending Bond

- Instead use the space for a classroom building
- Create a cost-effective gymnasium renovation










Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

• 1,192 seats












Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

Phase II- Competition Gym

- Opening up the gym wall is technically challenging but creates a gym with over 2,500 seats!
- A unique asset for the Higley Community










Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

 Gym can still be divided into two separate gyms for classes, overlapping sports, and smaller assemblies










Phase I, Phase II and Beyond

 Opening Height allows for competition basketball and pep rallies










