Review High School Transcripts and Credits

- Are there additional credits needed (APS, graduation, admissions requirements)? Meet with your counselor ASAP for planning.
- Check college/university of interest for admission requirements (i.e., do 8th grade credits count, foreign language or fine arts requirements, testing requirements, etc.)
- Request dual enrollment/articulated classes for college transcripts. (i.e., request UAA transcripts)

- Use AKCIS for free online career interest inventory, college searches, scholarship searches, and more!
- Use Common App for college searches.

Apply for Admission - Be aware of deadlines!

- Early Admission** (Consider if binding or non binding!) vs Regular Admission?
- Request official high school and university transcripts** through CTHS website and UAOnline accounts.

All graduates:

- Request letters of recommendations and official transcripts in advance.
- Verify diploma name with Registrar
- Order cap, gown, other swag from Josten's • Submit quote/photo via CTHS Class of 2024 Google Classroom by January 19, 2024
- Report scholarships and offers of admission to your counselor prior to graduation!

Complete the FAFSA (students and parents)

- Application opens on October 1st at <https://studentaid.gov>

The earlier you apply, the more aid you may be eligible to receive, however you cannot apply until the year you plan to graduate. Even if you know you will not be eligible for need based aid, this is still required for many other financial aid sources.

Search and Apply for Scholarships

- Review options with the Admission/Financial Aid office at the school(s) to which you are applying. Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS)
 - Meet the course, GPA, and test requirements as shown on the APS Handout.
 - The FAFSA is your APS application. Complete the FAFSA by June 30th and select a participating Alaska post secondary institution.
- UA Scholars – top 10% of graduating class, determined the end of Junior year. FAFSA application required by May 1st to hold the scholarship application.
- Build your postsecondary portfolio
 - Resume/Activities/Community Service
 - Letters of Recommendation (you can request through the Counseling Homepage) www.matsuk12.us/cts
 - Personal Goals essay
 - Work Experience
 - Official Transcript – request through link on www.matsuk12.us/cts
