Process of uploading:

1. Open "Enter Marks" box
2. Enter marks. Close box.
3. Open "Verify Marks" box.
4. Verify marks. Close box.
5. Open "Submit marks" box.
6. Click to submit marks.
7. Wait for work to show up on eCoursework
8. In eCoursework, find each student's name.
9. Upload correct document(s) for each student.
10. Meet in person with student
 - a. Open preview screen for every single assignment they are submitting.
 - b. Get student's verbal consent for me to upload their work
 - c. Get student's verbal agreement that the work they are submitting is their own authentic work.
11. Submit uploaded work.
