Board Policy**

OATH OF OFFICE

In accordance with statutory provision, each new director shall take an oath to support the constitutions of the United States and the State of Washington and to promote the interests of education and to faithfully discharge the duties of his/her office according to the best of his/her ability. A school district officer or notary public authorized to administer oaths must certify to this oath and the signature of the member and file three (3) copies of the signed oath of office with the educational service district superintendent who shall forward copies to the county auditor and the state Superintendent of Public Instruction.
