

Tumwater School District Board Policy

COMMITTEES

From time to time the Board may appoint sub-committees of the Board to meet with groups of staff or citizens, or to study a matter which is before the Board for consideration and action.

No individual member and no group comprised of less than the full membership shall be designated as a standing committee to perform any of the Board's functions permanently.

At the request of the Board, the President shall appoint temporary committees comprised of less than the full membership for special purposes and/or projects. These committees shall be discharged on the completion of their assignment. The President of the Board shall be ex-officio a member of any such committee.

It is the policy of the Board that sub-committee members serve only to gather information for subsequent reporting to the full Board and in no case will the members of the sub-committee either suggest action or make any representation which may have the effect of committing the full Board, either expressly or implied, to any line of action.

Individual Board members may participate on committees facilitated by district administrators representing the Tumwater School District. No more than two Board members will serve on any single district administrator-led committee. In no case will Board members on those committees either suggest action or make any representation which may have the effect of committing the entire Board, either expressly or implied, to any line of action.
