Board Policy**

LAW ENFORCEMENT VISITATIONS

The Board of Directors recognizes that law enforcement agencies, in the conduct of investigations and other business, may contact school officials and/or visit school buildings for a variety of reasons.

It is the Board's intention that district personnel will cooperate with law enforcement agencies and their personnel in the conduct of their duties, subject to and in accordance with established district policies.

The Board expects that law enforcement officials, in the conduct of their business, will adhere to all procedures established by the respective law enforcement agencies and will exercise respect for the rights of all concerned parties.

Any interrogations and/or searches shall be conducted in the presence of a building administrator/designee unless the administrator/designee's presence is not allowed by the law enforcement officer per RCW 26.44.030. The Board expects that a reasonable attempt will be made to notify parents of any student subject to such proceedings on a school campus or school sponsored activity.
