ALLERGY & MEDICAL CONCERNS

A special diet form is required when a child needs extra attention regarding their food intake during the school day. Students with physical disabilities, allergies that affect life function and diabetes <u>must</u> complete a **Medical Plan of Care for School Food Service** form every school year in order for menu changes to be made by the Food Service staff in your child's school. You can request one from the Cafeteria Manager or Nurse, or from the CV Food Service website. After the form is completed by the physician and the parent, return it to the Cafeteria Manager. A meeting may then be scheduled with the Cafeteria Manager, Food Service Director, School Nurse, Parents and Student to discuss dietary needs.

Please note that Conestoga Valley School District will **NOT** provide a milk substitution for a student with a **non-disabling special dietary need**.
