In the educational landscape, both PSSA ELA and Math achievements bear significance. The proficiency and advancement rates reflect minimal progress, with 47.1% of students reaching the Proficient/Advanced level in ELA and 26.4% in Math. Additionally, the implementation of an evidence-based schoolwide positive behavior interventions and supports system (PBIS) holds promise in fostering a conducive environment for growth, enabling students to thrive academically and socially.
