recess.



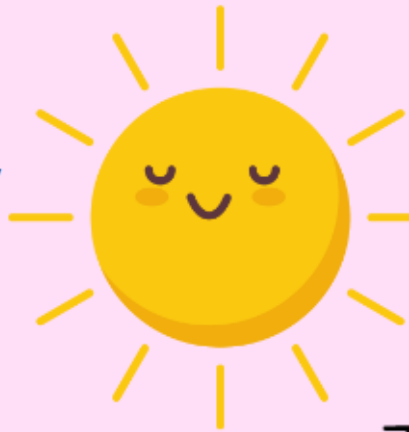

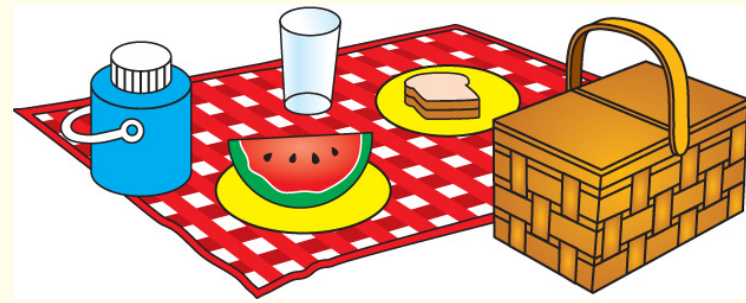
