Dear Families,

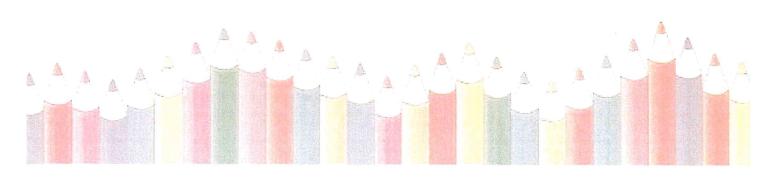
