

What can CalFresh be used for?

- Food for you and your family to eat
- Seeds and plants to grow food for your use

Who can receive CalFresh?

Any one, any age, who is a legal U.S. resident, lives in Placer County and meets the income limits (see chart).

If I am receiving SSI/SSP, can I also receive CalFresh?

If you are receiving SSI/SSP, you are already receiving CalFresh benefits in your monthly benefits. But your family may still qualify to receive CalFresh.
