

## Post-Game Activity: Thank and Recognize Your Partners

You can never thank partners enough. You should thank them in advance when they agree to meet you, thank them during their visit and thank them after their visit.

Create a list of how to thank your partner or potential partner:

- Ⓚ While they are on campus
- Ⓚ After they leave campus



Be sure to mention what they did and how it will benefit your students. Take photos and use social media whenever possible to thank and recognize partners throughout the year.
