# **<u>TOPIC</u>:** APPROVE REVISIONS TO THE 2022 - 2023 TRADITIONAL, INTERSESSIONAL, AND EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL CALENDARS

# **BACKGROUND**:

On January 25, 2022 the Fort Worth ISD Board of Trustees approved the 2022 - 2023 school year calendars. Calendars were developed with input from District stakeholders including the District Advisory Committee (DAC) and District Employee Relations Council (DERC).

The Juneteenth National Independence Day federal holiday was signed into law on June 17, 2021. In observance of the new federal holiday, the approved calendars have been revised to include June 19, 2023, as a District Holiday. The workday schedules for employees that are impacted by this revision will be adjusted with no impact to their annual salary.

The revised 2022 - 2023 Traditional, Intersessional (Alice Carlson and Jo Kelly), and Early College High School Calendars still meet the state requirement of 75,600 operational minutes.

# Encouraging Governor Greg Abbott to Call a Special Session to Protect Our Schools from Mass Shootings

**WHEREAS,** the 2022 Spring semester ended in a statewide tragedy with the mass shooting at Robb Elementary in Uvalde, Texas, leading to the loss of 19 children and 2 teachers;

WHEREAS, our nation has a long list of mass shootings, to include the Midland-Odessa shooting, the El Paso Walmart shooting, the Santa Fe High School shooting and the Sutherland Springs Church shooting, all occurring in Texas within the past 5 years;

WHEREAS, our students, parents, faculty and staff should not be in fear that mass shootings and gun violence will occur within FWISD and our community, as our schools must be a safe refuge for our children and the adults charged with their care;

**WHEREAS,** the Texas Legislature can take action to protect our children from mass shootings and senseless gun violence by implementing common sense reforms that focus on our children's safety and security wherever they gather, be it our schools, houses of worship and other public spaces;

**WHEREAS,** the Texas Constitution requires the Governor to call the Legislature into Special Session, and although three special sessions have been called since the end of the 87<sup>th</sup> Regular Session on May 31, 2021, none focused on prevention of mass shootings and gun violence.

# NOW, LET IT BE HEREBY RESOLVED,

**THAT** the Board of Trustees of the Fort Worth Independent School District calls upon Governor Abbott to call a special session of the Texas Legislature to protect our children from mass shootings and gun violence before the beginning of the 2022 – 2023 academic school year; and

**THAT** the Board of Trustees of the Fort Worth Independent School District calls upon the Governor to include common sense policies that protect our most precious Texas resource, our children.

# **Statutory Requirements**

"Under the authority of Texas Government Code, Section 551.001, et seq., the Board, during the course of the meeting covered by this notice, may enter into closed or executive session for any of the following reasons:

- 5. To consider the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices. Sec. 551.076
- 6. To deliberate a case involving discipline of a public school child or children, unless an open hearing is requested in writing by a parent or guardian of the child; or to deliberate a case in which a complaint or charge is brought against an employee of the District by another employee and the complaint or charge directly results in a need for a hearing, unless the employee complained of or charged requests an open hearing. Sec. 551.082
- 7. To exclude a witness from a hearing during the examination of another witness in an investigation when the Board is investigating a matter. Sec. 551.084
