Why Now?



Fort Worth ISD needs a comprehensive, multi-year plan that <u>establishes priorities aligned to the current needs of our community</u> as we provide a high-quality education for ALL students.

Strategic Plan Objectives

1. Establish strategic **priorities** aligned to the needs of our community.

3. Establish a system for measuring and reporting district **progress**.



2. Provide a roadmap for **implementing** our priorities.

4. Strengthen ongoing, two-way communication with students, families staff and community.

Strategic Planning Community Engagement

Community Advisory Committees

- ✓ Actively participate in meetings, including meeting attendance, pre-work, and group operating norms.
- ✓ Seek to understand and represent the needs and interests of the community (not just personnel perspectives).
- ✓ Work collaboratively with committee members to define district priority needs, goal/objectives, and strategy recommendations for Action Teams.

Community Advisory Committees Membership: 15 – 20 members per committee; including students, parents, campus and district staff, political leaders, community and faith-based organizations.



Strategic Planning Process



Phase 1: Board Call to Action

- ✓ Superintendent presents proposal for strategic planning process
- ✓ Board approves technical assistance (TA) partner organization for strategic plan development

Phase 2: Strategic Priorities and Committee Orientation

- ✓ Fort Worth ISD Executive Team identifies strategic priority areas based on listening tour feedback from 2022-2023
- ✓ Identify and develop key resources (data) for each strategic priority
- ✓ Create orientation for Community Advisory Committees aligned to each strategic priority

Strategic Planning Process

Phase 3: Community Advisory Committees

- ✓ Advisory Committees participate in multiple meetings to review District data and define priority needs, goals/objectives, and strategy recommendations that are aligned to each strategic priority area.
- ✓ TA partner organization facilitates meetings and drafts final committee reports.



Phase 4: Action Teams

- ✓ Action Teams develop detailed multi-year plans aligned to priority needs, goals/ objectives, and strategy recommendations from Community Advisory Committees.
- TA partner organization co-facilitates with Action Team leaders to draft each strategic priority plan report

Strategic Planning Process

Phase 5: Community Feedback

Collect community feedback on strategic plan draft through multiple avenues, including surveys, community forums, focus groups, and individual meetings.

Phase 6: Board Adoption

Fort Worth ISD reviews and approved Strategic Plan during public meeting

Phase 7: Progress Monitoring and Improvement

- ✓ Superintendent provides quarterly updates on strategic plan milestones metrics, including a comprehensive annual report on Strategic Plan progress.
- ✓ Establish a Strategic Plan Community Council to review and provide feedback on District progress quarterly.

Technical Assistance (TA) Partner Selection Process

- ✓ Fort Worth ISD solicited proposals from local and national organizations.
- ✓ The District received 6 qualified proposals.
- ✓ Proposals were assessed based on the following criteria:
 - Level of Experience in Providing Strategic Planning Support
 - Cost (Competitive and Commensurate with the Scope of Work)
 - Readiness to Begin Work in September 2023
- ✓ District Management Group (DMGroup) was identified as the optimal partner based on the assessment criteria.
