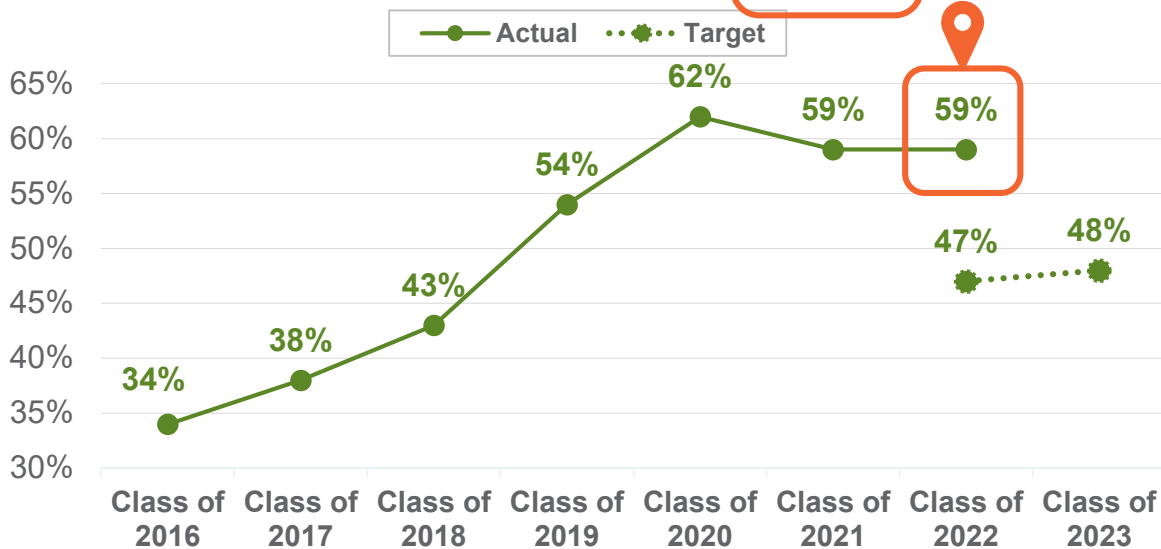
Board Outcome Goal 3: CCMR

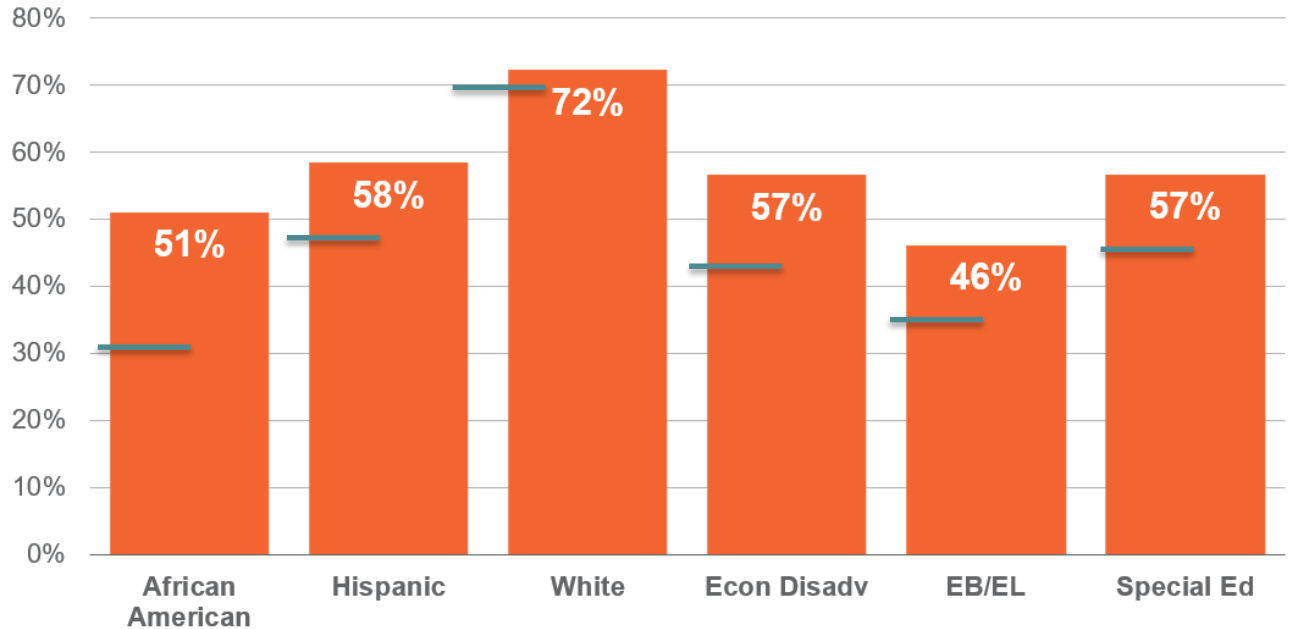
Board Outcome Goal 3: Class of 2022 – Update

of students in the Class of 2022 met at least 1 CCMR Indicator.

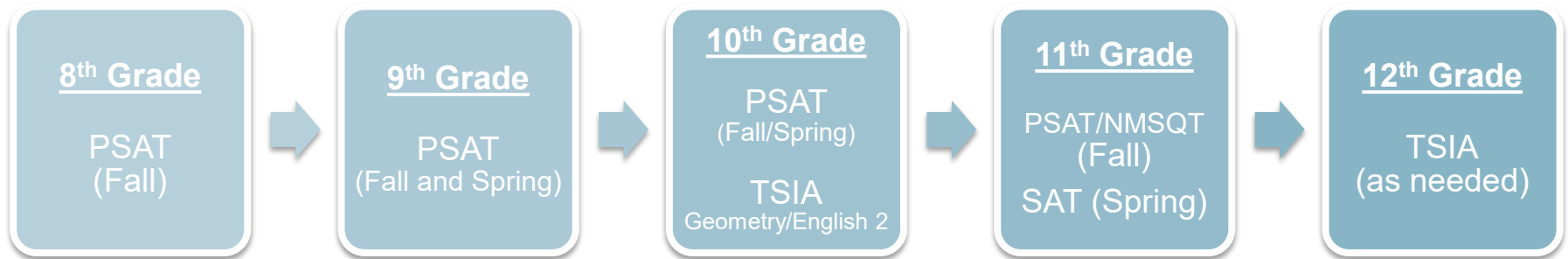
% of Class of 2022 Who Met at Least 1 CCMR Indicator



Collegiate Exam Continuum

PSAT: Nationally-normed exam to create a baseline, progress monitor, and adjust instruction

SAT and TSIA: Used as a measure of academic college readiness and to support post-secondary plans (SAT Benchmark: R/W = 430 ; M = 530)



Collegiate Course Offerings

Advanced Placement

- 35 courses offered
- Students qualify for college credit if they earn a 3-5 in the end of year exam.

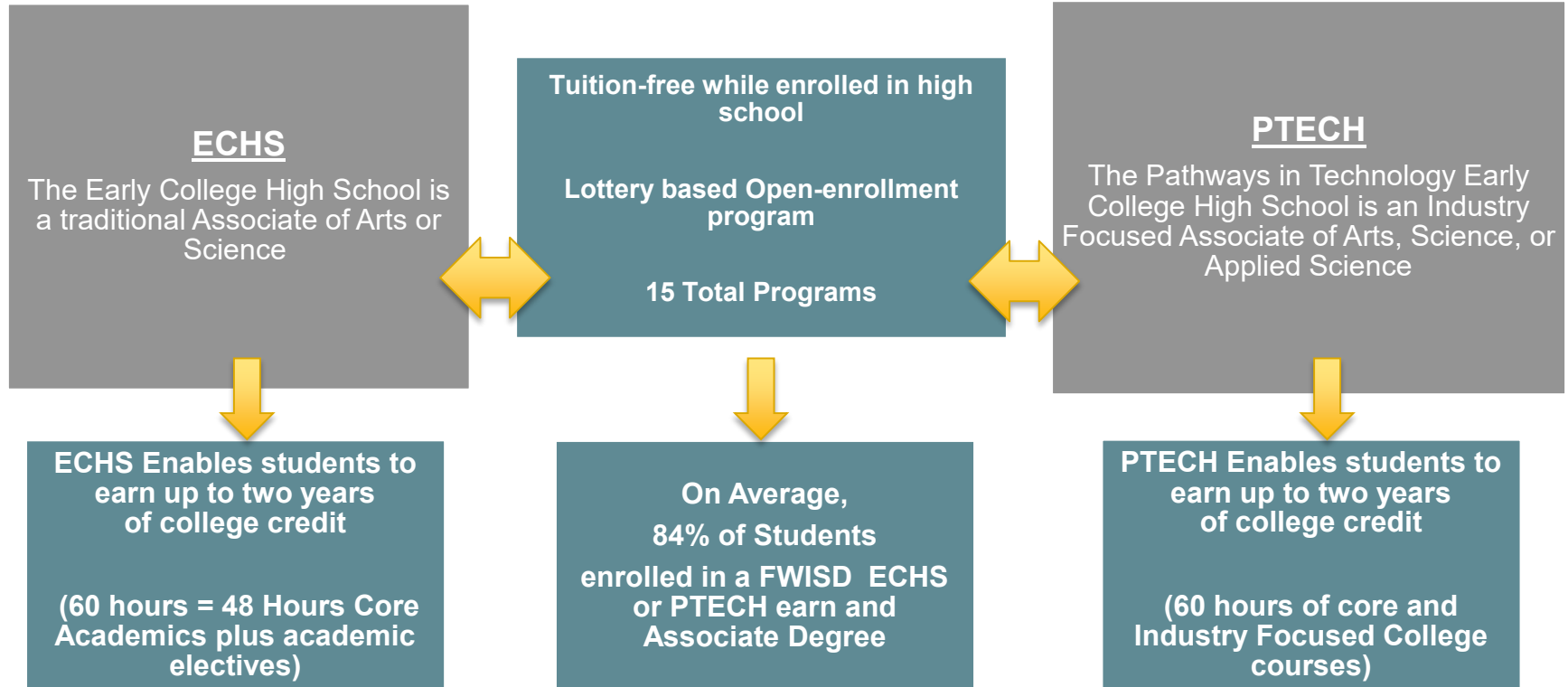
Dual Credit

- 78 different courses offered
- 2021-2022 Total course enrollment of 11,040 with 87.4% Success Rate
- Students must meet TSIA benchmarks before taking CORE dual credit courses.

OnRamps

- Dual Enrollment with University of Texas
- 19 different courses offered
- Open to all students; no exam needed. Eligibility for credit is based on student performance in the course.
- Blended course taught by a UT professor and FWISD Teacher

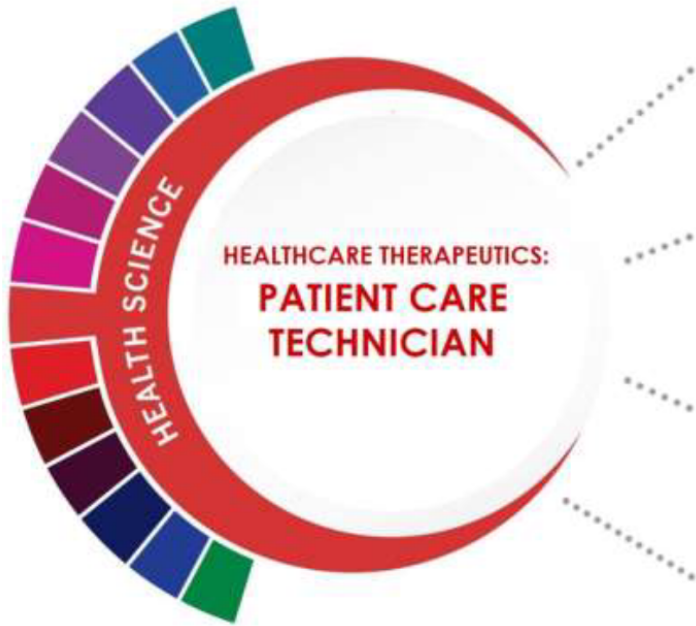
