


Class of 2022 % who met at least 1 CCMR indicator **exceeds** the goal for every group based on *preliminary* data through summer 2022.



## **Collegiate Exam Continuum**

**PSAT:** Nationally-normed exam to create a baseline, progress monitor, and adjust instruction

**SAT and TSIA:** Used as a measure of academic college readiness and to support post-secondary plans (SAT Benchmark: R/W = 430; M = 530)



## **Collegiate Course Offerings**

#### Advanced Placement

- 35 courses offered
- Students qualify for college credit if they earn a 3-5 in the end of year exam.


#### **Dual Credit**

- 78 different courses offered
- 2021-2022 Total course enrollment of 11,040 with 87.4% Success Rate
- Students must meet TSIA benchmarks before taking CORE dual credit courses.

#### OnRamps

- Dual Enrollment with University of Texas
- 19 different courses offered
- Open to all students; no exam needed. Eligibility for credit is based on student performance in the course.
- Blended course taught by a UT professor and FWISD Teacher


