





2022 District Rating

2017 "what if" calculated using current rules; 2020 & 2021 no ratings – global pandemic




14 point gain over 5 years despite two years of global pandemic




STAAR Performance by Racial Category

Percent Passing at *Approaches Grade Level* or Above






