

- Identify and build core IT processes that automate ITbusiness alignment




Identified Top Priorities

* E-Rate is an FCC program for schools and libraries which seeks to make network infrastructure more affordable. Schools are allocated monies every five years to upgrade network components. Districts are only liable for 15 to 20 percent of total cost of allocated funds.


 Create a culture that empowers and equips every student with the tools and resources to achieve their greatest potential.

Project Initiative – Interactive Flat Panels




- Project will replace all aged smart boards and projectors with Interactive Flat Panels.
- Project has begun with replacement or addition of panels in High School classrooms not covered under renovation.
- Project will replace over 5,000 units Districtwide.
- Anticipated Completion Dates

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- High Schools (650 units) October 2022
- Alternative (100 units) July 2022
- Elementary Schools (3150 units) September 2023
- Middle Schools (1440 units) December 2023

Project Initiative – Video and Access Control



- Project will replace all access controls and video cameras at all schools.
