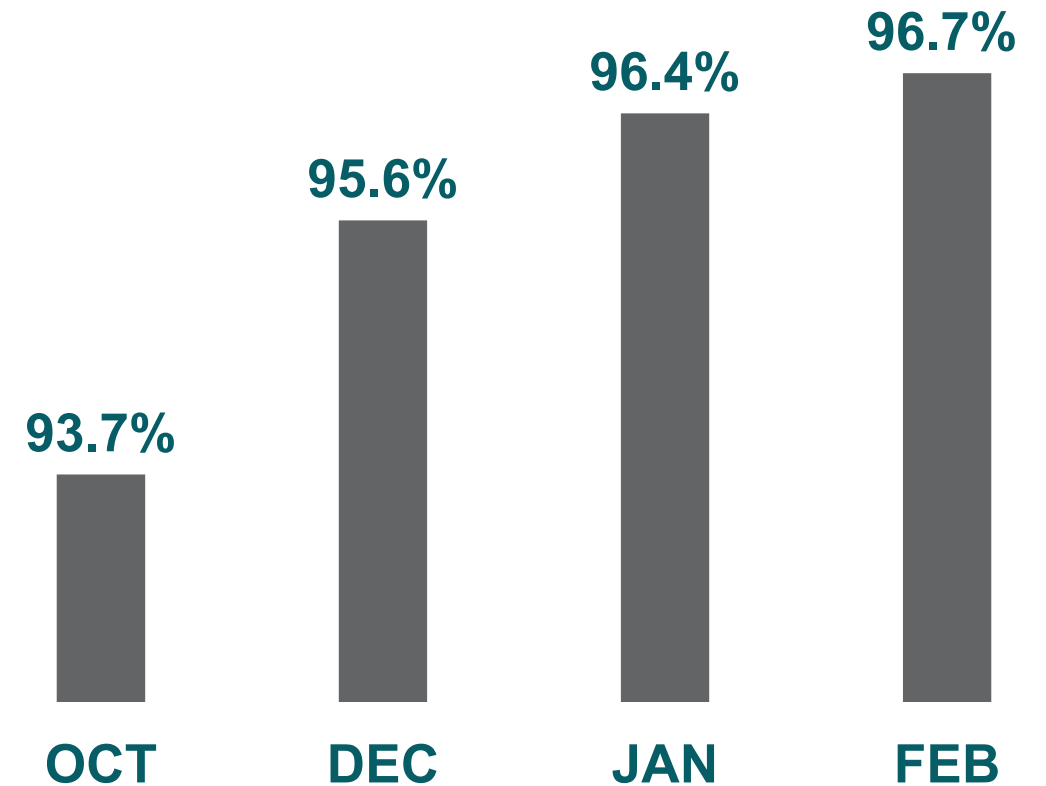

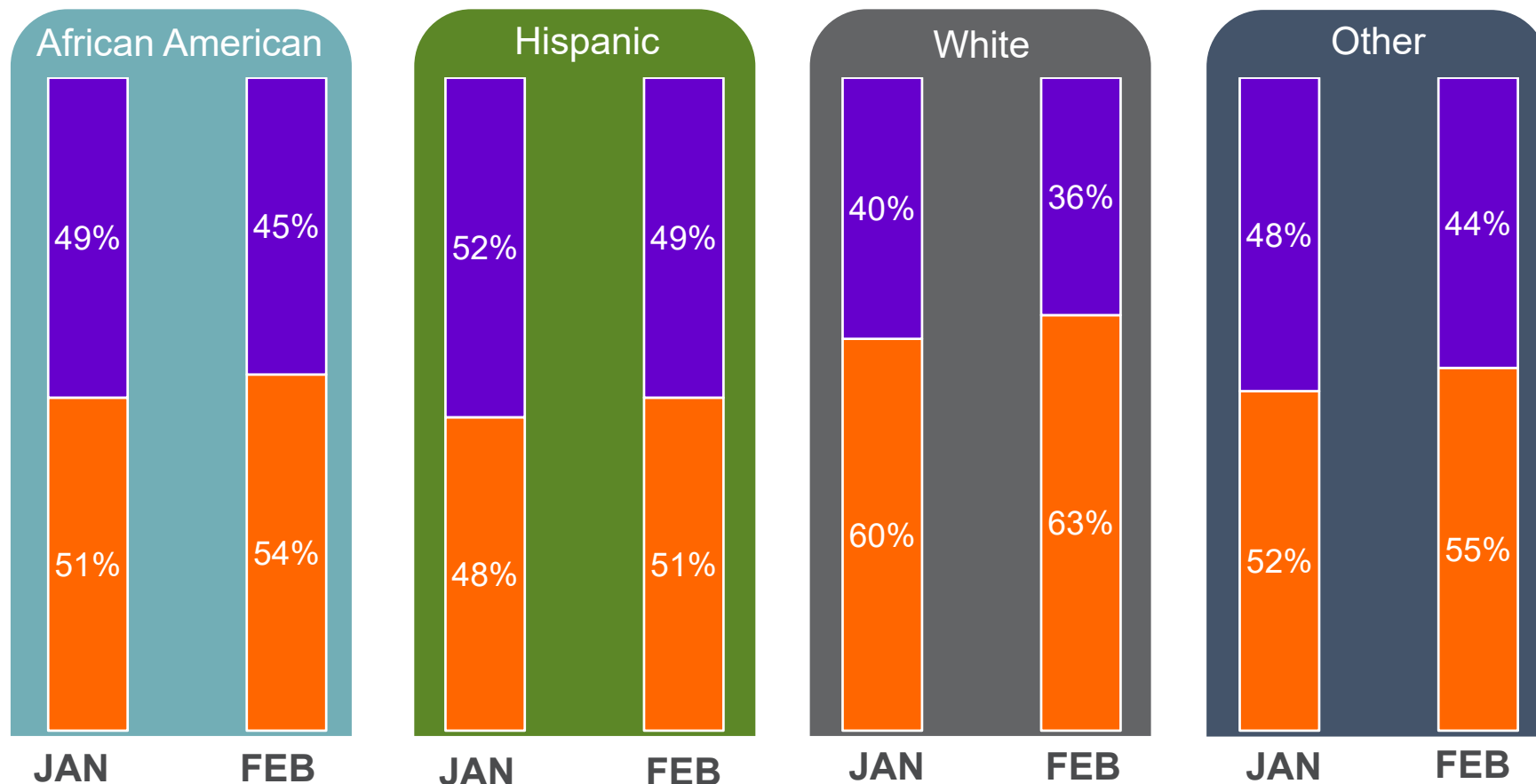

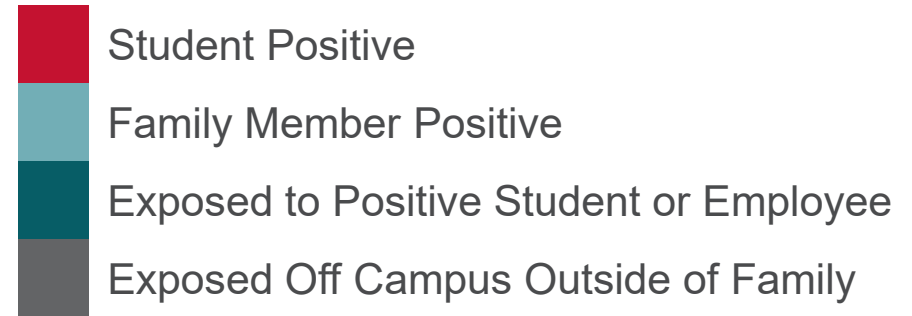

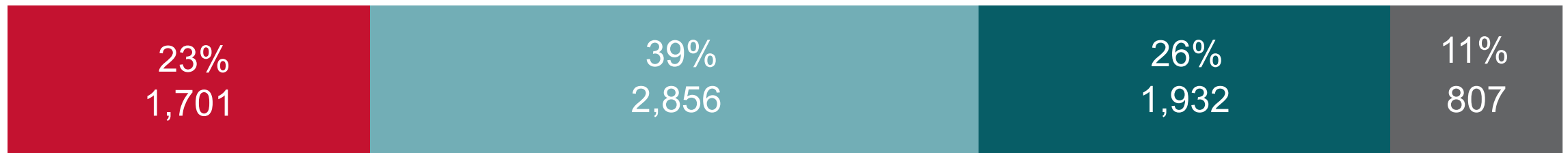
COVID-19 Trends

Student COVID-19 Data from October 5 – February 22



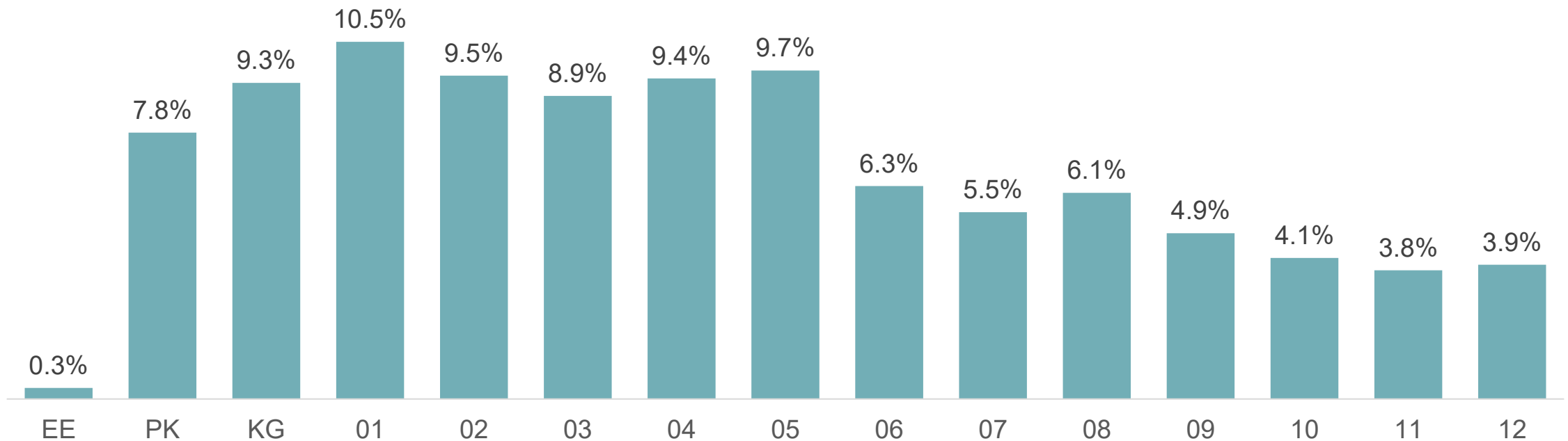
The summary data includes students attending live instruction and those participating in UIL Athletics. **(7,296 Total)**



Prior to the first date of In-Person Learning (September 8 - October 3, 2020) there were 12 positive student COVID-19 cases all were High School students participating in UIL activities.

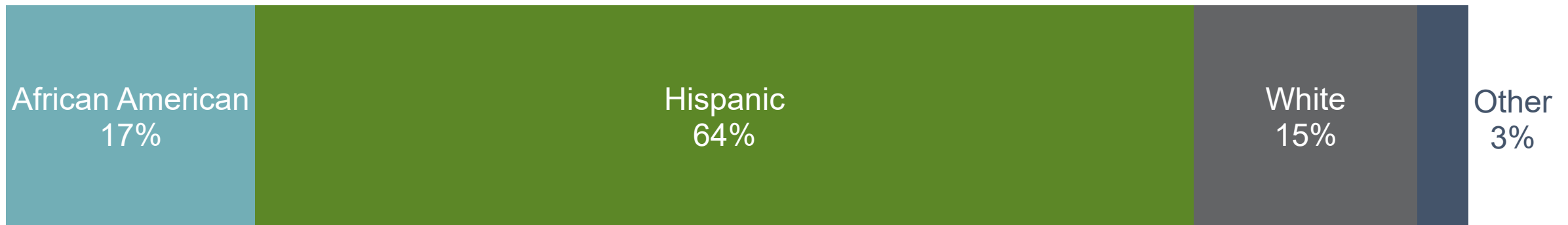
COVID-19 Trends

Student COVID-19 Breakdown by Racial Group

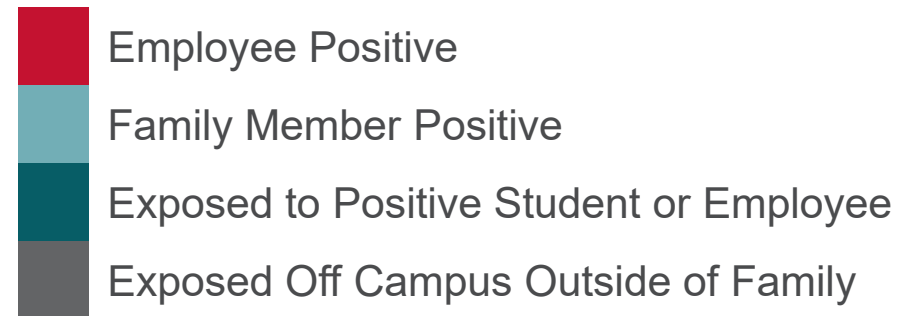

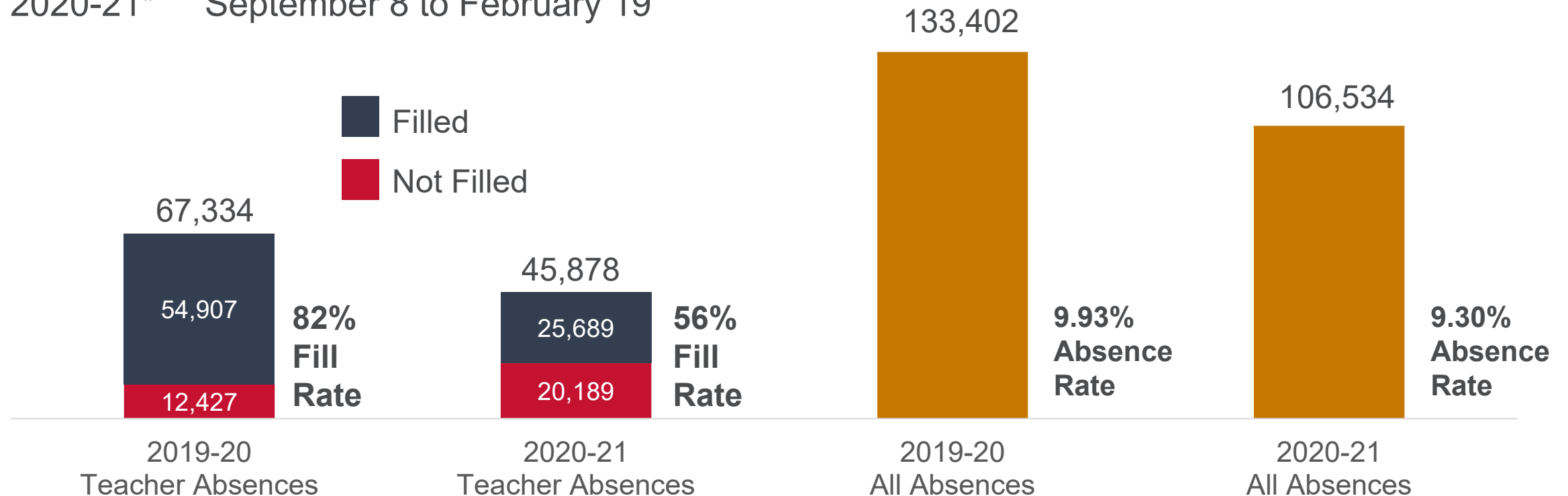
Staffing Impact
