





Change in Learning Environment: We have students in various learning modes (in-person, virtual, hybrid) for 2020-2021 compared to all in-person in 2019-2020.






**Mid-year Update:** In English, a slightly smaller percentage of PK students were ontrack in Math in January 2021 than at the same time in 2020.

### % On Track for Math – PK Year-to-Year Comparison




Mid-year Update: Only the Special Ed group has a slightly higher percentage of PK students on-track in Math in January 2021 compared to January 2020.

### % On Track for Math – PK Year-to-Year Comparison English & Spanish Combined




**Mid-year Update:** In English, a slightly higher percentage of PK students were ontrack in Math in January 2021 than at the beginning of the year in September 2020.





### % On Track for Math - Kindergarten Year-to-Year





### % On Track for Math - Kindergarten Year-to-Year




Mid-year Update: A greater percentage of Kindergarten students were On-Track for Math at middle of year than at the beginning of the year.
