




2020 Student Ethnic Distribution






Student Enrollment by Program 2020








Attendance 2018-2019 School Year






Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 7-8) 2018-2019 School Year






Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 9-12) 2018-2019 School Year





4-Year Longitudinal Graduation Rate (Grades 9-12) Class of 2019 Cohort





Average SAT Score, All Subjects Class of 2019 Cohort



Average ACT Score, All Subjects Class of 2019 Cohort




2020 Teacher Ethnic Distribution






2020 Teacher Years of Experience
