


















# COVID-19 Dashboards

Student COVID-19 Data from October 5 – January 22




The summary data includes students attending live instruction and those participating in UIL Athletics. (6,210 Total)

#### Student COVID-19 Breakdown by Grade Level






#### Student COVID-19 Breakdown by Racial Group






#### **Teacher and Employee Total Absences**

2019-20 August 19 to January 20




