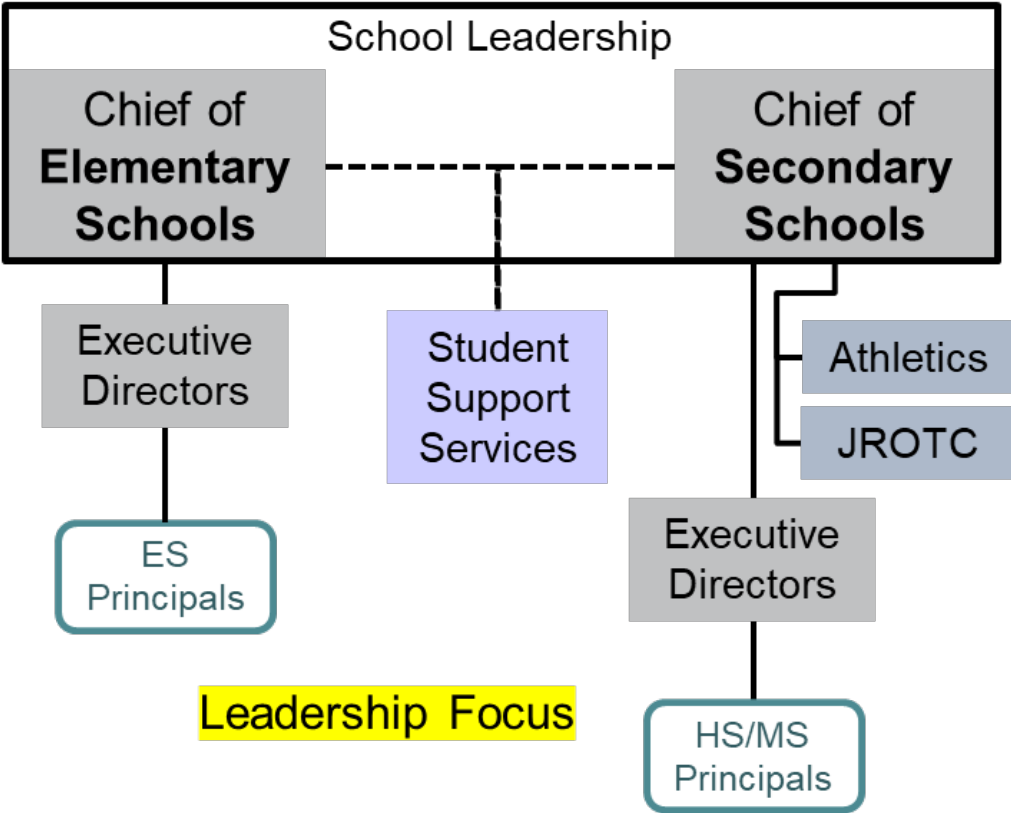

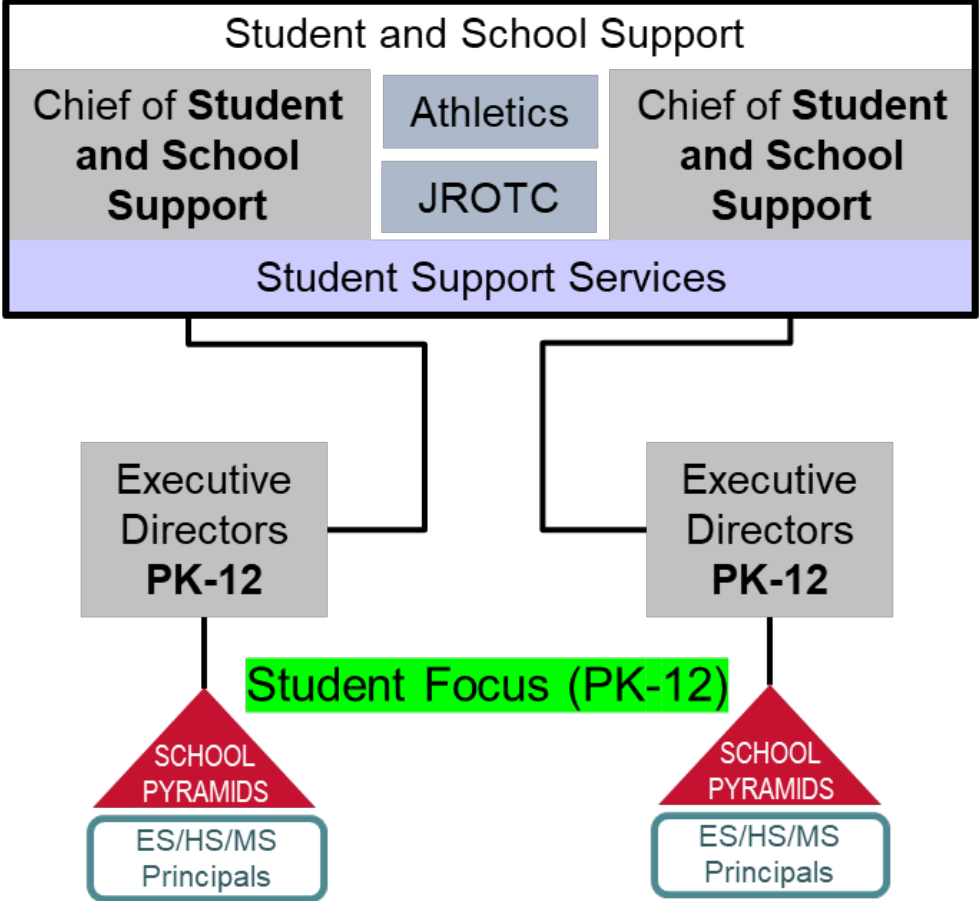

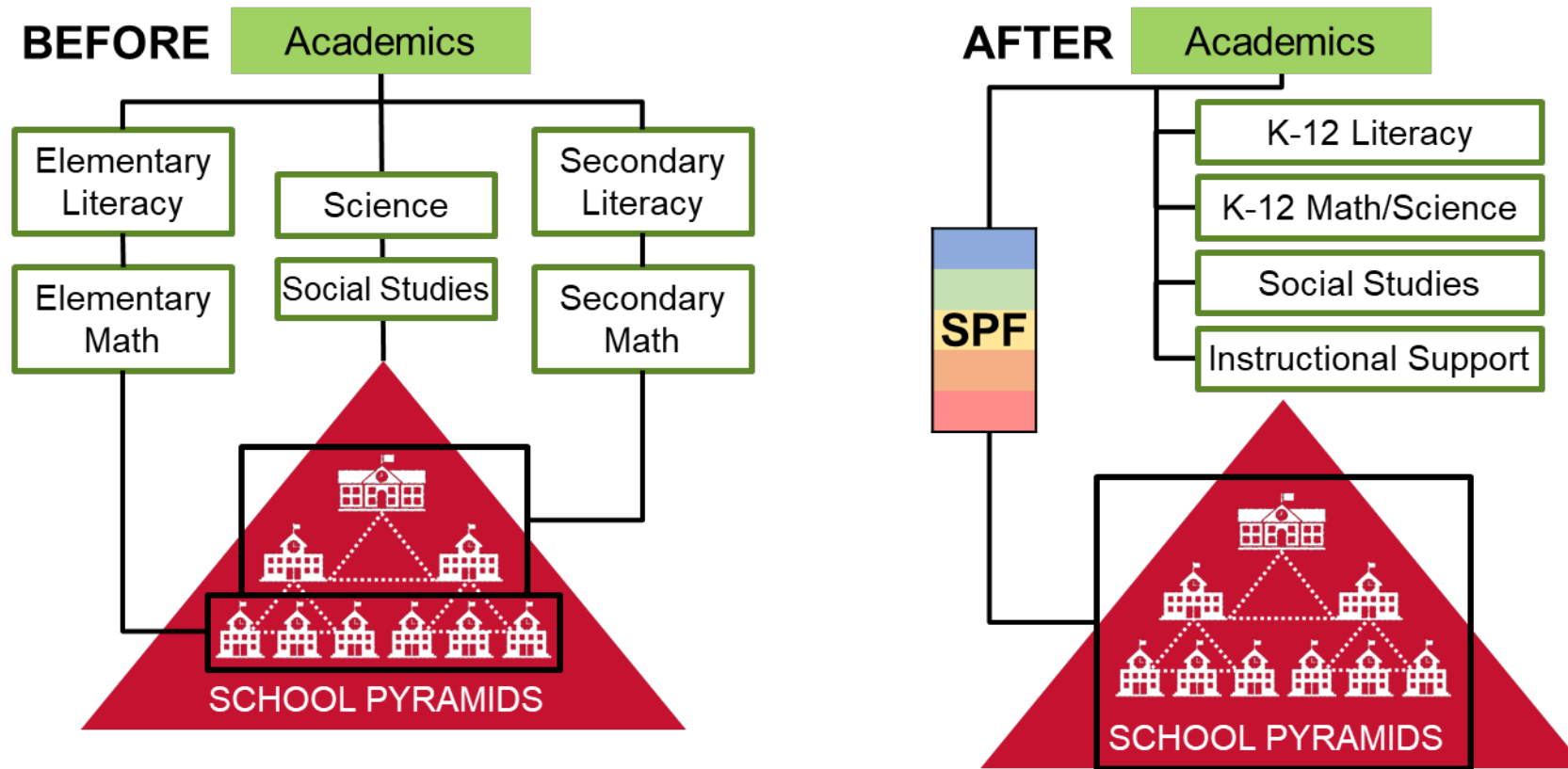

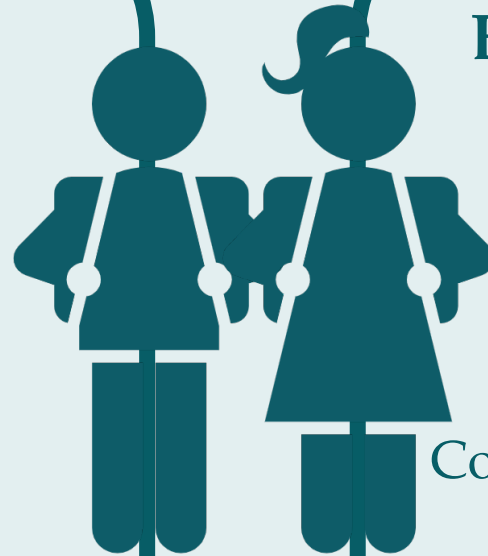
Specialized Academic Support Services
