

Even Start & Family Literacy*

Outcomes

- NAEYC accreditation
- Funding increased/Number of families served doubled (30)
- 83% of the parents have made academic progress within their programs
- 88% of children are developmentally on target, compared to 38% upon enrollment
- 70% of the participants have obtained employment


