GETTING TO KNOW YOUR HOTSPOT



LED DESCRIPTION

Part	Description
Power key	Hold the Power key for 3 seconds to power the device on/off.
WPS key	Hold the WPS key for 3 seconds to activate the WPS function. Once activated, the Wi-Fi LED indicator will flash every 2 seconds. If the network is not accessed within 2 minutes, it will exit WPS mode.
LED indicators	Displays Wi-Fi, signal, battery, and SMS status.
Charging in USB Port	Use the USB Type-C port to charge your device and connect your device to the client via the USB cable.
Charging out USB port	Use the USB port to charge other devices, such as tablets and smartphones.
Reset	Press Reset key for 3 seconds to reset device. All LED indicators will flash blue 2 times to indicate that the device has been reset to factory mode.
Reboot	Hold Power key for 10 seconds to restart device.

TURN ON HOTSPOT

- 1. Press the **Power** button on the mobile hotspot until all four indicators momentarily flash blue.
- 2. Wait for the **Network** and **Wi-Fi** Indicators to come on, one at a time.
- 3. When the <u>Network and Wi-Fi icons</u> light up blue, the Wi-Fi connection is enabled.

TURN OFF HOTSPOT

- 1. Press the Power button on the mobile hotspot until all four indicators momentarily flash blue.
- 2. When all four buttons go dark, the Network and Wi-Fi connections have been disabled.

CHARGING YOUR MOBILE HOTSPOT




Charge using a charger and

USB data cable Connect the USB cable into the charging port as shown and connect the charger to a power outlet to start charging. When the device is powered off, it takes about 3 hours before being fully charged. Note: When red battery indicator lights up, device should be charged to protect the battery.

CONNECT YOUR WI-FI DEVICE TO YOUR MOBILE HOTSPOT

- 1. Press the power button to turn on your hotspot.
- Locate your hotspot's Wi-Fi name (SSID) and password. This information is on the label on the back of the hotspot.
- 3. Open your Chromebook and ensure that it has power.
- 4. Search for available Wi-Fi networks and click the **Wi-Fi** name (**SSID**) of your hotspot.
- 5. Enter the **unique password**.
- 6. Click **Connect**. The device will connect to the internet and will be labeled "Connected, secure". You will receive a message to Sign into your Chromebook.
- 7. Login to your Chromebook by using your FWISD student username and password.
