Connect to the Internet (Students)

Overview

In Fort Worth ISD, we have four different network options.

- **FWISD.LOCAL**: Wired network connection. This requires the computer to be hardwired to the network using an Ethernet cable connected to a drop in the wall.
- **FWISD**: District Wi-Fi Network used by staff and students with district issued laptops. Automatically connects when users log-in to their district laptop.
- **FWISDMDN:** Mobile Device Network used by district issued student devices to connect to the Internet. District managed student devices will automatically connect to this network.
- **FWISD-GUEST:** Network available to guests as well as students and staff using personal devices. Additional filters may be applied to the guest network.

Connect to the Internet-Chromebook

1. Click the Wi-Fi icon in the lower, right corner of the task bar on your Chromebook.



2. Click the Wi-Fi icon again to find the FWISDMDN network.



3. Click the FWISDMDN network. You should see Connected under the network once a connection is established.



If your Chromebook does not connect to the FWISDMDN network, connect to FWISDGUEST. The connection to the FWISDMDN network should connect once the network recognizes the device. If not, see your teacher or librarian for additional help.

Connect to the Internet-District Laptop

1. Click the Wi-Fi icon in the lower, right corner of the task bar on your laptop.



2. Click on the FWISD network.



3. Click Connect. Enter your district username and password if prompted.



The device will connect to internet and will be labeled "Connected, secure". If your laptop does not connect to the FWISD network, hardwire the device and log-in to the device. This should re-establish the device to the FWISD network. If not, see your teacher or librarian for additional help.

Connect to the Internet-District iPad

1. Click on the Settings icon.



 Select Wi-Fi from the choices on the left. Turn on Wi-Fi by toggling the Wi-Fi button to the on position. When Wi-Fi is On, the toggle should be green.

3. Select the FWISDMDN network from the list provided.



When you are connected to the network you will see the network listed under Wi-Fi. You will also see the Wi-Fi symbol in the top right corner.

Connect to the Internet- Personal Device

If you are connecting to the network, using a personal device, you can use the directions above for your device type. However, you will need to use the FWISD-GUEST network instead. This will apply additional filters to your browsing sessions, which means YouTube and other sites may not be available.
