

Using BenQ InstaShare to Screencast (Mac)

Introduction

Use the BenQ InstaShare App to screencast content from a mobile device to a BenQ Panel. Follow the steps in this Quick Reference Guide to untether instruction.

Getting Started

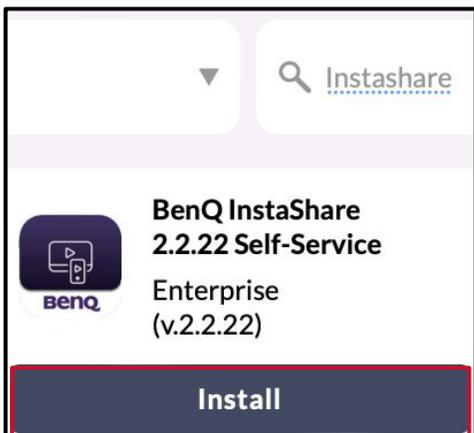
1. Open the **Mosyle Manager** in the Launch Pad or Dock.



2. Select **Self-Service** from the left-hand side menu.



3. Locate the BenQ InstaShare app and click **Install**.



Initiating InstaShare

1. Open the **BenQ App** on the MacBook.



2. Leave the **pairing window** open on the MacBook.



3. Open **Wireless Projection** on the BenQ Panel.

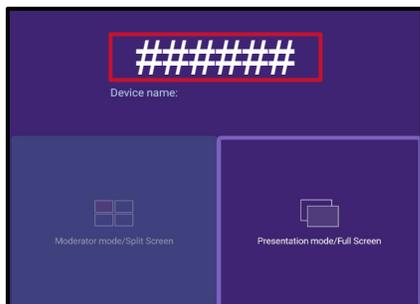


NOTE: If a user is not logged in to the BenQ Panel with an AMS account, the user will select Connection to access the InstaShare option.

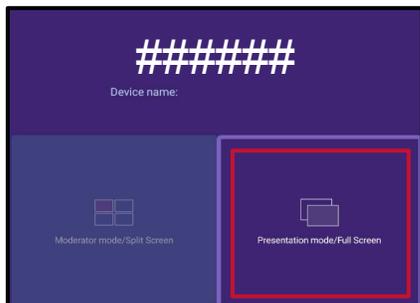
Using BenQ InstaShare to Screencast (Mac)

Screencast to BenQ Panel - Presentation Mode

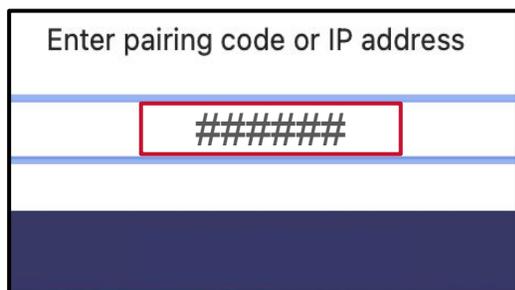
1. Locate the **pairing code** in InstaShare on the BenQ Panel.



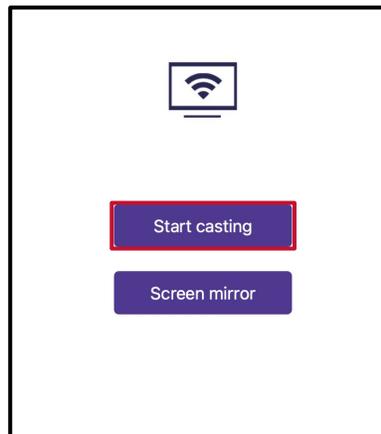
2. Select **Presentation mode/Full Screen** on the BenQ Panel.



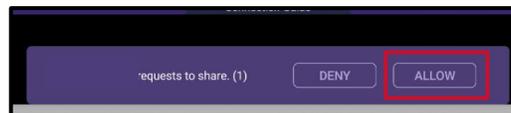
3. Type the **pairing code** into the InstaShare app on the MacBook.



4. Select **Start casting** from the InstaShare app on the MacBook.



5. From the BenQ Panel, select **Allow**.



6. The MacBook screen will now cast to the BenQ Panel.



Using BenQ InstaShare to Screencast (Mac)

NOTE:

*BenQ Panel offers a Moderator mode in InstaShare. This feature will allow multiple devices to cast to the board at one time.

**The InstaShare app on the MacBook allows for Screen Mirroring. This allows the board screen to be cast to the mobile device.
