

## How To Join FWISD Wi-Fi On a MacBook

### Introduction

This QRG will show you how to connect to *FWISD* Wi-Fi on a staff MacBook. The *FWISD* Wi-Fi is for teachers and staff only. If you are having issues connecting to certain websites with the new iBoss Connector while connected to *FWISDMDN*, joining the *FWISD* Wi-Fi should resolve this. Eventually *FWISDMDN* will no longer be in use.

### Joining FWISD Wi-Fi on a Staff MacBook

1. Sign into your MacBook and click the Wi-Fi icon on the MacBook's menu bar.



2. After clicking on the Wi-Fi, you should see a list of available networks in the dropdown menu. If you do not see the *FWISD*, click **Other Networks** and you should see a longer list of networks to join.



3. Click on **FWISD**.



4. To authenticate with the *FWISD* network, login with your full credentials and password with **firstname.lastname@fwisd.org** as the Account Name and click OK. **Do not select a certificate in the dropdown menu.**



If you see the following message window pop up while entering your credentials, just click Cancel, click on *FWISD* again, and login again. A trick to prevent this message window to pop up again is to try to login with your credentials as quickly as possible.



5. Once you have logged in, click Continue to Verify Certificate.



6. You'll see another window to authenticate locally with your device. Your name should automatically appear as the device local user, just enter your password again.

You should now be connected to *FWISD* Wi-Fi. Once connected, you shouldn't have to authenticate on your device again to reconnect.
