

Pairing the BenQ Remote to the BenQ Panel

The BenQ Panel is equipped with a wireless remote to help facilitate instruction while using the board. In the event the remote becomes unpaired, this guide will assist in pairing the remote control back to the BenQ Panel.

Getting Started

 Locate the BenQ remote on the back of the BenQ Panel. Looking at the back of the board, the remote will be velcroed to the top left-hand side.



Pair BenQ Remote

1. Locate the **USB receiver** on the back right-hand side of the BenQ Panel.



2. Point the **remote control** near the **USB receiver** on the back of the BenQ Panel.



3. Press the V- and BLANK buttons at the same time, and the indicator light will start flashing.



4. Pairing is complete once the **indicator has stopped flashing**.




5. To check remote function, point remote towards board and enable the pointer. If the red dot (pointer) appears and moves when the remote is moved, the remote has been paired.



Pairing the BenQ Remote to the BenQ Panel

BenQ Remote



Power Button You will not need to power on or off your display. The display is set up to go into standby mode. Tap the display screen to wake up from standby

Pointer Press to activate the spotlight or pointer function. Follow additional instuctions on the screen

SwitchQ a task switcher to switch between recent apps and input sources

Settings Press to open or close settings menu

Confirmation Button Press to 'OK' to select/proceed

Home Press to go to Android home screen

Return Button Press if you wans to go back

Microphone Press to use as mic for screen recordings (remote must be selected as the input mic in the settings menu)

Freeze Press to freeze/unfreeze screen

Blank Press for blank screen

Volume Volume up/down
