SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY PRACTICUM

The Psychological Services Department of Fort Worth Independent School District (FWISD) is accepting applications from graduate students who wish to complete various levels of field experience or formalized Practicum experience. As a large urban school district, FWISD offers an array of experiences working with a diverse population of children, adolescents, and young adults. Each graduate student's experience will vary as their training will be tailored according to the university's course requirements and the available opportunities within the district. The FWISD Psychological Services Department only accepts applicants who are currently completing graduate coursework in the area of School Psychology.

Field Experience is considered to be any pre-practicum experience which takes place prior to a formal Practicum. FWISD defines a Practicum Student as a graduate student who is in the last year of coursework before formal Internship, has accumulated approximately 350 hours of field experience, and requires a site-based experience that integrates all learned concepts in preparation for internship placement.
