

Caring for your new MacBook

A List of Do's and Don'ts

Do:

- ✓ Keep the plastic protective case on the MacBook at **all** times.
- ✓ Close the laptop before carrying it around.
- ✓ Place your laptop in a carrying case if you have one.
- ✓ Charge your MacBook every evening, and bring it to school fully charged.
- ✓ Be careful when carrying your MacBook in your backpack so that pressure is not put on the screen.
- ✓ Treat your Macbook as a prized possession. It is **YOURS** until you leave FWISD!

Don't:

- ✗ Carry your MacBook by the screen. The screen is very fragile and will break!!
- ✗ Place papers or other items in your closed MacBook. Again, fragile screen!!
- ✗ Place things on top of your MacBook.
- ✗ Loan your MacBook or charger to anyone else. Only **YOU** can be responsible for it.
- ✗ Leave your MacBook unattended.
- ✗ Eat or drink around your MacBook.
- ✗ No stickers, adhesives, or glues on the device or case because of the buy-back program. A slip of paper can be designed and placed between your clear cover and device with name, OS shortcuts, etc.
