

# Fort Worth ISD Standards of Dress

Students are expected to be in dress code. Violations of the dress code shall be handled at the school level.



# **Purpose and General Guidelines**

The District's dress code is established in an effort to improve student learning and to facilitate a safe learning environment. It is intended to instill discipline, prevent disruption, avoid safety hazards, and teach respect for authority.

The District prohibits any clothing or grooming that in a principal's judgement may reasonably be expected to cause disruption of or interference with normal school operations.

# **Guidelines for ALL Grades (Prekindergarten - 12)**

- Clothing shall be the correct size for students, with no sagging pants.
- T-shirts permitted on campus designated dress days.
- Shorts, skirts and skorts must be at least finger-tip length.
- Acceptable accessories include belts of a solid color fabric or leather.

### Prekindergarten - Grade 8

#### **TOPS**

- Color: Navy or white and campus designated school color.
- Style: Collared (polo or Oxford) shirts or blouses, mock turtlenecks or turtlenecks.
- T-shirts permitted on campus designated special dress days.
- Outerwear: Sweatshirts or sweaters in navy, white or campus designated sweatshirts are acceptable. Coats and jackets of any color shall be worn in accordance with weather conditions.

#### **BOTTOMS**

- Color: Navy, khaki, black or blue denim
- Style: Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, capris or jumpers are acceptable; Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be at least finger-tip length.
- Sagging pants are not permissible.

#### **SHOES**

 Style: Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes or other closed-toe shoes as well as open-toe / open-heel shoes are acceptable.







# **Secondary Grades 9-12**

#### **TOPS**

- Color: Any color is permitted.
- Style: Collared (polo or Oxford) shirts or blouses, mock turtlenecks or turtlenecks and t-shirts that are within dress code guidelines.

#### **BOTTOMS**

- Color: Any color is permitted.
- Style: Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, capris or jumpers are acceptable. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be at least finger-tip length.
- Sagging pants are not permitted.

#### **SHOES**

• Style: Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes or other closed-toe shoes as well as open-toe/open-heel shoes are acceptable. Shoelaces should be white or should match the color of the shoe.

# Unacceptable dress for ALL grades (Prekindergarten-12):

- Sagging pants.
- Clothing considered too revealing (bare midriffs, tube tops, tank tops, cut-off shirts, low-cut tops, crop tops, see-through shirts, clothing with holes, tears, or cuts, fishnet clothing).
  - "Too revealing = tending to show more typically hidden parts of the body"
- Clothing with lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene pictures, emblems or language.
- Clothing with advertising that depicts tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs or any substance prohibited under Board Policy FNCF (LEGAL).
- Gang-related clothing, accessories or jewelry bearing signs, insignias, colors or symbols.
- Sleep wear of any kind, visible drawstrings, boxer shorts, sleep caps or bonnets and houseshoes.
- Except for verified religious clothing, head gear such as hats, scarves, bandanas.
- Combs, sunglasses or grillz.
- Accessories that could be classified as dangerous or as a potential weapon, i.e., chains, spiked necklaces or bracelets, and the like.
