Our programs

We offer 194 courses during the academic year, including 50+ in fine arts and eight in entrepreneurship, and our summer campers choose from over 80 elective courses.

A four-year graduate of CMA and CGA has had 200 hours of instruction in our department of leadership education and 1,500 hours putting it into practice in our student life programs via eight formal leadership positions.

CGA students and CMA cadets have access to over 200 leadership positions.

Culver boasts over 60 athletic teams competing at the state and national levels.

In 2021, our Black Horse Troop and Equestriennes made their 18th and ninth appearances, respectively, at the presidential inaugural parade.

Annually, over 100 students participate in our GPS service & culture trips to destinations such as Tanzania, Italy, Ireland, South Africa and Costa Rica.

Eighty-seven percent of our faculty hold advanced degrees.

Culver offers nine spiritual life services to students, more than our peer institutions in the U.S.

Our students and campers

Our boarding students come from 40 states (80 percent domestic) and 24 countries (20 percent international) with significant pipelines in the Midwest, West Coast and Texas.

Interest in CMA and CGA is at an all-time high, with a record number of inquiries and applications for the 24-25 school year.

Our acceptance rate currently stands at 44 percent, a significant improvement over the last decade.

Seventy-five percent of admitted students decide to enroll, among the best at U.S. boarding schools.

Enrollment in Woodcraft Camp has been at max capacity for five years and enrollment in Junior Woodcraft has grown by 40 percent over the past decade.

Our campers come from over 40 states and 40 countries.

Our financial sustainability

A \$545 million endowment allows us to grant \$12 million annually in need-based aid to students and campers as well as \$4 million through the Distinguished Scholarship Program.

Our boarding school tuition remains 11 percent lower than the average top-10 East Coast boarding schools.

Our supportive alumni, parents, and donors give over \$6 million annually to fund our programming and operations.









Our campus

Our 1,800 acre campus includes 1,700 feet of lake frontage, 200 watercraft, 37,000 books in the Huffington Library and 300 acres of old-growth forest, in addition to the main academic, residential and athletic facilities.

All dorms and barracks will be refurbished and modernized by 2030, with all students residing in a central residential area.

Woodcraft Camp comprises 65 cabins, five of which were added in the last year.

There are 19,000 living members of our alumni associations, including auto racing legend Roger Penske, Olympians Kayla Miracle and Molly Engstrom, and managing partner of the N.Y. Yankees Hal Steinbrenner.
