USDA Under Secretary Honors DCSD Ag in Classroom Teacher

Pioneer Elementary School teacher Susan Irwin has been named the Agriculture in the Classroom's Outstanding Teacher Award recipient from the Colorado Foundation for Agriculture (CFA). This prestigious award recognizes Irwin's exceptional efforts in integrating agriculture into her classroom curriculum, fostering agricultural literacy, and inspiring students to become conscientious contributors to a sustainable global society.

The award was presented during a visit by the United States Department of Agriculture Under Secretary for Marketing and Regulatory Programs Jenny Lester Moffitt to Colorado to encourage producers to apply for the next round of funding of the Specialty Crop Block Grant (SCBG). During the event, CFA unveiled the 2024 project sponsored with funds from the SCBG: a book titled "Seed, Sprout, Spice! All About Pueblo Chiles." CFA is one of the 12 projects receiving funding from the SCBG program for the 2024 growing season.
